



Retaking Indigenous lands in Amazonia The Sataré-Mawé struggle to reclaim ancestral territory on the River Mariaquã









Why are the Sataré re-occupying the Mariaquã river?

> Andirá-Marau Indigenous Land

- 1. Ancestral territories inhabited after colonial era migration
- 2. Invaded by resource grabbers
- **3.** Abundance of food (i.e fish, game) and forest products (e.g. palm for thatch)
- Political division between Sateré aligned with Para (Aveiro m.) and Amazonas (Barreirinha m.)

Campo Branco

First Sataré reoccupation village on the Mariaquã

Ancestral Sataré territory invaded by resource grabbers - abundant land, wood, fish and turtles


Resex Tapajós-Arapiuns Andirá-Marau Indigenous Land Amazônia National Park
